#### **Looks forward to Federal funding announcement**

Independent Member for New England, Tony Windsor MP, has welcomed the visit by Acting Prime Minister, John Anderson to view the activities at the National Cutting Horse Association Futurity (NCHA) in Tamworth today.

“The Futurity is one of the great equine events of the Australian horse calendar and is an ideal example of the potential for growth in the industry once a new National Equine and Livestock Centre is constructed.

The Executive and Board of the NCHA have been one of the major drivers of the establishment of a new centre and deserve congratulations.
