### **Windsor asks Health Minister to meet cancer treatment campaigner**

The cause of Boggabri cancer treatment campaigner, Jenny Barlow was pushed this week in the Federal Parliament by the Independent Member for New England, Tony Windsor when he implored the Minister for Health and Ageing Nicola Roxon to meet with her when Mrs Barlow is Canberra next week.

Mr Windsor told the Parliament in his address-in-reply to the Governor General:

“I implore the Minister for Health and Ageing to meet with a constituent from the north-west, not in my electorate.

“She is a very devoted advocate of cancer treatment in terms of low-dose radiation and radiowave therapy.

“I would implore the minister for health to actually meet with Mrs Jenny Barlow.

“Mrs Barlow lost her husband to cancer a few years ago.

“She has been working with this technique that is used in various parts of the world.

“Mrs Barlow has proposed to build a clinic in Sydney where this procedure that has been taking place in many parts of the world can take place.

“She is asking this government, and she asked the former government and they ignored her, to put in place some facilities to monitor the outcomes from the treatment.

“She is not asking for money to build the clinic or to conduct the research—just to have health people there to monitor the adequacy of the procedure.

“Mrs Barlow will be in the House next week and I would ask the Minister for Health to spare some time to at least speak with her.”
