AUSTRALIAN DEFENCE MEDAL PRESENTATIONS

Member for New England, Tony Windsor, is honoured to be presenting Australian Defence Medals to recipients at the Armidale Ex-Services Club on **Tuesday 8 June 2010 at 12.00pm.**

Mr Windsor and Captain Mark Ingram of the 12th/16th Hunter River Lancers, will be presenting 3 past members of the Australian Defence Force with their Medals in recognition of their service and commitment to our Nation's security.

“The Australian Defence Medal was approved by Her Majesty the Queen in March 2006 and aims to recognise current and former Australian Defence Force Regular and Reserve personnel as well as volunteer and National Servicemen, who have served since the end of World War II,” Mr Windsor said.

The Australian Defence Medal is being awarded to Members who have completed their initial enlistment period or four years service, whichever was the lesser, since World War II with service backdated from 3 September, 1945. It is estimated that over one million serving and ex-serving ADF members will be eligible for the medal.

Eligibility has also been extended to personnel who have died during service or are medically discharged due to permanent injury making them unable to serve for the minimum qualifying period or those who have honourably served but due to Defence policy at the time were unable to serve for the minimum qualifying period.

“I look forward to joining Captain Mark Ingram to present these proud Australians with their medals and joining other invited community leaders in providing them with the recognition they deserve” Mr Windsor said.
